## JEDGARRA - SECTION 42(9),(10) & (11) DIRECTION

We refer to the previous direction dated 25 November 2025 (**Direction**), issued under the Ports Management Act 2015 (NT) (**PMA**), relating to the vessel Jedgarra that broke from its small vessel mooring during Tropical Cyclone Fina and is currently fouled against Stokes Hill Wharf (**Vessel**).

In accordance with section 42(2) of the PMA, you were directed to do one or more of the following preventative actions within 14 days of the Direction:

- remove the Vessel from the port;
- move the Vessel to another safe place within the port;
- repair the Vessel and make it safe;
- destroy the Vessel and all fittings and fitting on board;
- sell or otherwise dispose of the Vessel, and all fittings and equipment on board.

The 14-day timeframe has passed. Darwin Port has not received any response or engagement from you concerning the Direction and the Direction has not been complied with.

In accordance with section 42(9) of the PMA Darwin Port intends to remove the Vessel from Stokes Hill Wharf and move it temporarily to Polaris Marine Constructions , 5 Cochrane Rd, East Arm NT 0822.

In accordance with section 40(10) and (11) of the PMA, this notice provides 28 days' notice of Darwin Port's intention to sell, dispose or destroy the Vessel.

Darwin Port will seek to recover all costs incurred in removing the vessel from Fort Hill Wharf, temporarily storing the Vessel, and either selling, disposing or destroying the vessel, as a debt due and payable in accordance with section 42(15) and 42(17) of the PMA.
