To the owner, master and/or occupier of Jedgarra

VESSEL JEDGARRA - SECTION 42(10) & (11) DIRECTION

We refer to the vessel Jedgarra that broke from its small vessel mooring during Tropical Cyclone Fina and fouled against Stokes Hill Wharf (**Vessel**) and the following directions that were issued to you in accordance with the *Ports Management Act 2015 (NT)*:

- direction dated 25 November 2025 (**Direction 1**), issued under section 42 of the PMA requiring preventative action to be taken in 14 days; and
- direction dated 16 December 2025 (**Direction 2**) issued under section 42(9), (10) and (11) of the PMA advising Darwin Port's intention to remove the Vessel from Stokes Hill Wharf and either sell, dispose or destroy the Vessel.

Darwin Port has not received any response in relation to Direction 1 or Direction 2.

On 14 February 2026 Darwin Port arranged for the Vessel to be moved from Stokes Hill Wharf and secured at Polaris Marine Constructions, 5 Cochrane Rd, East Arm NT 0822.

It is Darwin Port's opinion that the Vessel is unseaworthy and the cost of repairing it to make it seaworthy, or the cost of storage and sale, exceeds its value

In accordance with section 42(10) and (11) of the PMA, this notice provides 28 days' notice of Darwin Port's intention to destroy the Vessel.

Darwin Port will seek to recover all costs incurred in removing the vessel from Stokes Hill Wharf, temporarily storing the Vessel, and destroying the vessel, as a debt due and payable in accordance with section 42(15) and 42(17) of the PMA.
