- Utilise MEX to ensure that maintenance tasks are recorded, assigned correctly, and completed to the relevant standard / specification.
- Ensure that you understand and apply Darwin Port Policies, standards and procedures including safe work and environmental practices in performing all duties and responsibilities.
- Contribute positively to continuous improvement activities and initiatives at Darwin Port.
- Other duties as directed by management from time to time.
